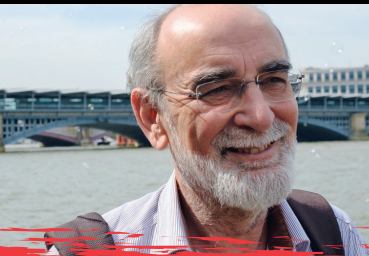

NO TO THE DISREGARD OF INTERNATIONAL TREATIES

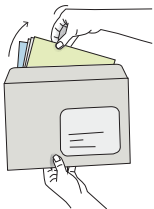

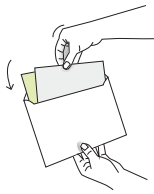

Original voting envelope open here



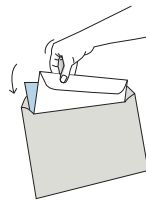
Voting list fill in the fields



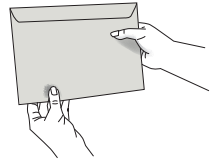
Place voting list in the small anonymous envelope and seal

Post the envelope to the local governmental office by 17th November or deliver it personally in the mailbox of your local governmental office by 24th November
